Applied Relational Research

"Empathetic Geocoding" Pilot Project (2022–2025): a three-year research project in 4 kindergarten sections (approx. 80 children/year) focused on empathy development through Circle Time and Total Physical Response (TPR) techniques.

"Scuola di Relazione" Applied Research (2017–2019): empirical study in middle school classes (N=70) using Likert-scale questionnaires to measure the effectiveness of Transactional Analysis concepts in relational competence development.
